

MEDORA PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION
Official Proceedings on November 21, 2017
(Subject to board review and approval)

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Doug Ellison. Present were Aaron Axvig, Ben Brannum and Jim Bridger. Kinley Slauter was absent. Minutes from the October 17 meeting were reviewed. Bridger made the motion to approve the minutes. Second by Brannum. Motion passed unanimously.

Application No. 17-36, a proposal from ND Cowboy Hall of Fame at 250 Main Street for signs placed on the new patio, was reviewed. This application had been tabled at the October 17 meeting. Slauter submitted an email to the Commission stating he had met with Rick Thompson from the NDCHF. Thompson thought it was a reasonable compromise to remove the Alvin Nelson sign and photo from the north and south ends of the patio. Nelson approached the Commission stating he had not purposely avoided submitting the signage requests to Zoning. Since the photos on the back wall and the NDCHF lettering on the stage are not intended to advertise and can't be viewed from the street, he requested that they be allowed to remain. Bridger made the motion to approve No. 17-36 with the removal of the north and south signs and photos and keeping the other signage in place as originally presented. Second by Brannum. Motion passed unanimously.

There being no other business, Brannum moved to adjourn. Without objection, meeting adjourned at 6:08 p.m.
