

MEDORA PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION
Official Proceedings on January 16, 2018
(Subject to board review and approval)

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Kinley Slauter. Present were Aaron Axvig, Doug Ellison, Jim Bridger, and Ben Brannum. Minutes from the December 19 meeting were reviewed. Axvig made the motion to approve the minutes. Second by Ellison. Motion passed unanimously.

Application No. 18-01, a proposal from TRMF at 310 5th Street for 2 wooden arbors by the Schafer house, was reviewed. Brannum made the motion to approve No. 18-01 as presented. Second by Ellison. Motion passed unanimously.

Application No. 18-02, a proposal from TRMF at 485 Broadway for sidewalk connecting Broadway and the stage behind the Von Hoffman house, was reviewed. Slauter added that the purpose of this sidewalk is to have a safer route for guests going to the stage behind the Von Hoffman house. The concrete will be dyed a bark color and lay flat with the lawn. Bridger made the motion to approve No. 18-02 as presented. Second by Brannum. Motion passed unanimously.

Under Misc. Business, Slauter informed Commission that the City Council upheld the Zoning Board's recommendation regarding the violation of No. 16-45. Slauter recommended we still look at Model Ordinances regarding fences. Steffen reminded the Commission that the term Doug Ellison was completing will expire 3-31-18.

There being no other business, Brannum moved to adjourn. Without objection, meeting adjourned at 6:13 p.m.
