Meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by President Kinley Slauter. Present were

Minutes from the February 20, 2018 meeting were presented to the Board for approval. Bridger made the motion to approve the minutes. Second by Brannum. Motion passed unanimously.

Application No. 18-07, an application from TRMF to install 3 business signs at Elkhorn Quarters, was reviewed. Sign 1; 5' x 10' double-sided sign by front entrance. Sign 2; 2' x 12' sign attached to log entrance gate. Sign 3; 2' x 16' sign on front lobby building. No old Bunkhouse signing will remain. The material of the signs will be the same as what's been used on the Old Town Hall. Brannum made the motion to approve Application No. 18-07 noting that the double-sided sign will count as one sign, second by Ellison. Discussion-Slauter noted he has done research regarding his potential conflict of interest on TRMF matters and he does intend to vote if necessary on matters involving TRMF. Motion passed unanimously.

Under Misc. Business, Slauter stated that the privacy fence which was not approved under application 18-06, will be submitted as a separate application when TRMF is ready to proceed. Doug Ellison was appointed by the Medora City Council to serve on the Zoning Commission for a 5-year term.
